Since 1982, The Rotary Club of Plainfield has been honored to provide scholarships to graduating high-school seniors who reside in Plainfield School District #202. We are proud to continue our scholarships in 2018. However, we are expanding our program to also include all students entering the trades, who are currently participating with Wilco. We will be allocating a total of \$5,000 to the most deserving scholarship applicants. Each scholarship will range from \$500-\$1,000. We can't guarantee each school will have a scholarship recipient.

The purpose of the Rotary scholarship is to aid students that are accepted and will be attending a college, university, trade school or trade work experience in their field. Scholarship recipients will be announced at the Senior Awards Night.

We feel that this new process will have a more direct impact on our Plainfield community. We are glad to be able to include all students continuing their secondary education for their future careers or trade work experience in their field.

### To be considered for this scholarship student must:

- Reside within School District #202
- Maintain a C+ GPA or better (3.5 on a 5.0 scale) \*verified by guidance counselor
- Convey a financial need for the monies through a short essay
- Promote "Service Above Self" through extra-curricular and volunteer service
- Display motivation and career direction through a short essay

#### Deadline:

Scholarship essay portion <u>must be typed</u> and submitted with application to the Guidance Department/Student Services <u>no later than Friday, April 6<sup>th</sup></u>. In order to be fair to all concerned, applications that are not typed and late submissions cannot be accepted.
